Slipped Agitha Smolder Key:

1. Read this as fast as you can and try not to make mistakes – while doing this, keep this in mind:

Mistakes may occur from the word combinations because of their senselessness (I appreciate the sort of “mistake” words that end up forming).

2. Only breathe where there are periods
3. Comma means brief pause/hesitation
4. Two commas mean pause a little longer than only one comma
5. Italicized means lean on the pronunciation
6. Parenthetical phrases should be slightly lower pitch wise
